#### **Details:**

This exclusive newly-built finca is under construction on a plot of approx. 15.124 sqm between Felanitx and Manacor. During the initial building phase the new owners will have the opportunity to influence the choice of materials to suit their own taste.

The plans foresee a modern finca with a light-flooded interior, using elements such as glass, natural stone and steel to create a modern design and harmonic atmosphere. The choice of only the highest quality materials will assure the highest level of comfort.

A green-planted patio leads to the entrance, from where a large entrance area gives access to the openly-designed living/dining area with adjoining kitchen. Here floor-to-ceiling windows allow the entry of ample natural light whilst offering a flowing connection to the external areas. A covered terrace provides ideal shade on warm summer days. Three double bedrooms each with en-suite bathroom and dressing area provide ample space for the whole family, rounded off by a utility room and a guest WC.

The Mediterranean-style garden will be lovingly laid out, perfectly incorporating an existing olive grove. In the evenings wonderful sunsets can be enjoyed from the terrace, and the unobstructed views of the Tramuntana mountains present an absolute highlight! During the hotter summer months the 32 sqm pool will provide welcome refreshment.

Further features of this wonderful finca include air conditioning, underfloor heating, and automatic garden irrigation.
