Details:

This unique finca makes it unnecessary to choose between living in a village or in the countryside. It stands on an approx. 26.618 sqm plot of land and was built in 1963 on the outskirts of Santanyi, only a short walk from the village centre with all its amenities.

It was completely renovated in 2000 whilst taking care to preserve its original Mallorcan character.

On the ground floor is the spacious living area, a separate enchanting and fully-equipped kitchen with a cosy dining area and fireplace, and a large double bedroom with en suite bathroom. Natural-stone elements bestow a special feeling of well-being throughout.

Housed on the upper level is a beautiful bedroom with bathroom en suite which has access to a private terrace with wonderful sweeping views, and a further 2 bedrooms which share a bathroom.

In the external area are 2 large covered terraces offering welcome shade during the hotter summer months, and a bbq zone inviting to al fresco cooking and dining with friends and family. In the midst of lovely Mediterranean nature absolute privacy can be enjoyed whilst taking a cooling dip in the 15 x 6 metre saltwater pool.

The garden has been designed to be low-maintenance and is decorated by palm trees and lawns, leaving ample space for more plants and fruit or olive trees if required.

An absolute highlight of this exceptional property is its existing touristic rental licence for up to 8 persons.

Further features of the finca include air conditioning, central heating, a storage room, and a carport for 3 cars.

Added to that there is an existing licence to enlarge the property by 150 sqm.





Location & surrounding area:

Santanyí in the southeast of Mallorca is among the most popular villages of the island and has resisted over centuries Romans, Arabs and pirates. The beautiful small city with its golden façade of sandstone is elevated from the green surrounding and attracts tourists as well as residents on Wednesdays and Saturdays to the colourful weekly market. Around the Plaza Mayor, there are various cafés and restaurants offering a broad culinary selection. The surrounding narrow streets with beautiful shops invite you to stroll.

The natural preserve of Mondragó is nearby offering numerous routes for hikers, whereas the idyllic bays at the east coast, as Cala Santanyí or Cala Llombarts are perfect for bathing. The harbour of Portocolom and the golf course of Vall d'Or are at a short distance.
