#### **Details:**

This beautiful chalet, built in 2005, stands on on a large plot of 620 sqm in the region of Barcares, near to the old town area of Alcudia and to diverse beaches. Its living space is distributed over two levels and has an area of approx. 210 sqm.

On the ground floor is a fully equipped kitchen with pantry next to the bright living/dining area, 2 double bedrooms, and a bathroom.

Housed on the upper floor there are 3 further double bedrooms with fitted wardrobes, one of which has a private, south-facing terrace, and another bathroom..

Its double glazed windows, air conditioning and a fireplace assure pleasant and cosy temperatures throughout the year. Both levels have parquet flooring.

In the exterior area is a beautiful private garden, a south-facing wooden terrace in front of the 18 sqm pool, an additional outdoor dining area and an outdoor bathroom.

A special feature of this property is its valid touristic rental licence for up to 8 people, offering the possibility to generate additional income and increasing its investment potential.

All-in-all this lovely chalet in Barcares offers an ideal combination of a spacious living space, ample outdoor amenities, and great rental potential, making it a very attractive real estate option.

Alcudia, which in the Middle Ages was actually the original capital of Mallorca, offers one of the longest beach promenades of the island and has a correspondingly perfectly developed infrastructure, as well as some very interesting sub-areas that you should definitely be visited. Surrounded by an impressive city wall, the old town of Alcudia offers a strikingly clean and orderly appearance throughout and exudes a unique charm, especially at early evening. Alcudia, which is geographically situated on a peninsula but also offers two very interesting residential areas; Bonaire in the north and Aucanada in the south.


