#### **Details:**

This wonderful town-house is located in a small, quiet side-street near to the 'Golden Mile' of Palma - the famous Paseo del Borne - and is only a 2-minute walk from Jaime III avenue with its fine boutiques and shops. It is Just a stone's throw from the 'street of the gallery owners', with diverse international contemporary art shops.

A highlight of the house is the private roof terrace, which has a covered area with a small breakfast- kitchen, a sun deck with lounge, a private pool perfect for cooling off on hotter summer days, and an outdoor barbeque-kitchen.

The entrance area provides a traditional ambience with a typical Mallorcan stone floor and modern wooden elements. A private garage with an elaborate ceiling design, indirect lighting elements, and Mares stone walls provides ample space for a car. There is also a convenient lift connecting all levels of the house, including the terrace.

The main living area is located on the 2nd floor of the property, and its heart is an elegant, fitted designer-kitchen by Poliform which has a cooking island in fine Italian natural stone, and a wooden snack bar. An elegant lounge area with a gas-fireplace by Kalfire in a stone and wood setting provides a cosy ambience even during the cooler months of the year.

On the 1st floor is the spacious master-suite with en-suite bathroom. The elegant suite boasts a ceiling height of 3.5 metres, setting new stylistic accents. Matt black fittings and a rain-shower from ICONICO and a walk-in wardrobe provide a very individual style. An additional guest room with its own bathroom is also located on this living level and would be ideal for children or guests.

This exceptional offer is completed by the VIP guest suite, with a bedroom flooded with natural light and providing views over the inner courtyard. This exclusive ambience is complemented by a walk-in wardrobe and a bathroom.





#### **Location & surrounding area:**

Palma's old town is ideal for those wishing to live in the midst of city life, with its small, sleepy squares, narrow alleys, wonderfully picturesque buildings, lively shopping streets and restaurants and cafes.

In this part of the town something is always happening, and here the most places of interest can be found including the famous cathedral La Seu, built between the 14th and 19th centuries, the Arab baths, the Almundaina palace or the well-known nightlife-quarter La Lonja. The history of the capital of Mallorca can truly be felt here.
